Join the Henrico Police Athletic League and former NBA star Johnny Newman for the 13th Annual Basketball Camp. The camp is designed for boys and girls of all skill levels, and focuses on improving and enhancing the basic and essential skills of individual team play. This is accomplished by ensuring that each camper participates in individual skill competitions, as well as game situations.

The Henrico PAL is a youth crime prevention program that utilizes educational, athletics, and recreational activities to create better trust and understanding between police officers and youth.

The camp is open to boys and girls at least 7 years of age, but no older than 15 years old. The camp will be held for 1 day from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The campsite is conveniently located at Eastern Henrico Recreation Center in Henrico County. The camp fee is \$25.00 per child.

The camp is designed to provide each camper with an enjoyable and rewarding learning experience. The campers are divided into teaching groups based on age, size, and ability. This is done in order to address individual needs and to foster self-confidence. We also deliver the PAL message, which consist of staying in school, and anti-drug messages.

ABOUT JOHNNY NEWMAN

Johnny Newman's accomplishments as a veteran of the National Basketball Association are truly remarkable. While the average NBA career is just over four years, Johnny managed to stay competitive as a guard and forward in the NBA for 16 years. All the while, he has maintained his image as a player with an outstanding and professional character. Given the endless distraction of playing professional sports, Johnny Newman believes in the importance of sportsmanship, character and integrity. While some athletes abandon the idea of serving as role models for youth, Mr. Newman embraces this notion and believes in giving back to the community.

Mr. Newman's NBA Career Highlights:

- **Eclipsed the 20-point mark 10 times in 2000-01**
- **Ranked 17th in the league in free-throw percentage in 2000-01**
- **Ranked 16th in the NBA in free throws per 48 minutes (5.98) in 2000-01**
- **Led the bench in scoring 30 times for the Nets in 1999-2000**
- **Scored his 10,000th career point against the Sacramento Kings on 2/12/98**
- **Played in 313 consecutive games before sitting out against the Orlando Magic on 1/13/98**
- **Hit 18 free-throws in 21 attempts, totaling a game-high 31 points, against the Minnesota on 11/28/97**
- **Led the Hornets in scoring in 1990-91 with a career best 16.9 PG**
